



Videofluoroscopy

Is used to image body functions in real-time.

It is ideal to observe swallowing and assess disorders of swallowing (including regurgitation or reflux) and to look for airway/tracheal collapse with coughing.

It is performed without sedation. It is often the most useful test for assessing these actions which are not well assessed with radiography, ultrasound and other tests.

Videofluoroscopy is performed by our radiologists with the patient in a standing position and often takes less than 30 minutes. Results provide immediate answers about function. Access to this study is limited to specialist hospitals with radiologists on site.

Videofluoroscopy is available as part of a suite of tests that is offered at Animalius to help ensure the most accurate assessment of your pet.
