animalius Tips to optimise your referrals

- Have all the relevant patient information readily accessible before starting your referral.
- Always send your anaesthetic record: it helps us plan.
- Use a structured approach to write your referral. For example:

Preparation

Identification

Question

U

Urgency

Education Modifications

Discussion

Situation

Background

Assessment

Request

Medicine, Dentistry & Surgery

- Communicate your primary concern, all the comorbidities and state whether your concerns are different to the clients.
- Collate and curate documents: Label them!
- Don't start new medications (especially antibiotics), immediately before referral.If in doubt, seek advice.

Rads, biospy results, blood work

Highlight urgency

Accurate list of comorbidities & associated workup





Pain Clinic

- Provides a plan: assessment, pharmaceutical options, interventional procedures.
- Does not provide diagnosis or diagnostic interpretation. Please provide these.

Radiology outpatient studies (US, CT, MRI)

For these cases, you have primary control and are responsible for managing the results, next steps (including medications or treatments), and any referral to another service.

Provide:

Clear clinical question

Provisional diagnosis

Relevant clinical history & additional diagnosis

Red flags!

Highlight red flags: are there any specific concerns or dangers that you are aware of? Is there anything else important we need to know? Medications, comorbidities, surgeries?
